
We recognize that none of these projects are possible without the community's support. We want to thank the members of Monterey Vista Community for their timely assessment payments and regular care and maintenance of their properties.

REMINDERS

Driving: Monterey Vista has many children in residence. Please drive cautiously and slowly down our streets.

Trash can(s) are to be stored out of public view on non-collection days. Please store trash can(s) inside garage or behind fence at all times. *Fines* will be sent if

trash cans are left out on non-pick up days.

Weeds: Due to the abnormal early warm weather, weeds have started to sprout very quickly. Please make sure all weeds are pulled and front yards are sprayed to prevent weeds.

Bulk Pick up Items: Please remember that if you have bulk items needing to be thrown away you must schedule bulk pick up with the City of Chandler Solid Waste Service. The weekly trash crew will not pick up these items. If you plan on placing bulk items out for pick up please contact City of Chandler solid waste service to at 480-782-3510 to schedule pick up and Kaile your community manager to avoid any violations.

Dogs in the Community:

It is the responsibility of each homeowner and tenant, who owns an animal, to make sure that the animal is not offensive to neighbors. Please be considerate of neighbors and minimize the amount of barking from you dogs. This includes quieting barking dogs if you leave them outside all night or for extended periods of time. Please also pick up animal waste in your yard, if it does not get picked up an offensive odor can be smelled by your neighbors. Please remember to make sure dogs are on leashes at all times and use the disposal bags in the doggie stations to dispose of animal waste.
