ELIMINATE MOSQUITO RISKS

Here are a few tips from the Maricopa County Vector Control Office on ways to eliminate mosquito breeding and reduce the risk of bites:

- Eliminate standing water where mosquitoes can breed.
- Check for items outside the home that collect water, such as cans, bottles, buckets, old tires, and other containers.
- Change water in flower bases, birdbaths, planters, and animal watering pans at least twice a week.
- Repair leaky pipes and outside faucets, and move air conditioner drain hoses frequently.
- Avoid being bitten by mosquitoes when going outside at night by using insect repellent with DEET. Wear lightweight clothing that covers the arms and legs.

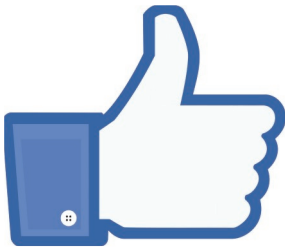

COMMUNITY REMINDERS



Residents with palm trees please remember to schedule annual trimming. Palm trees should be trimmed at the end of June. Not trimming your palm trees spread thousands of seeds throughout neighboring yards and common areas. This will cause juvenile palm trees to start growing where the seeds land. This also causes an increase in scorpions which live in the dead palm fronds.

If you have not yet trimmed your front or backyard palm trees please schedule an annual trimming.
